

BHEL Q1 net up 33 percent

In a regulatory statement, BHEL announced that its net profit has increased to Rs.3.84 billion for the quarter ended June 30, up from Rs.2.88 billion for the comparable period of the previous fiscal.

Similarly, total income too has increased by 34 percent to Rs.46.2 million in the current year's first quarter up from Rs.34.4 million in the comparable period of the previous year, the statement said.
