The risks covered by the insurer i.e. United India Insurance Co. Ltd. are death, total permanent disability & permanent partial disability. Even minor physical damage has also been covered.

Further, arrangement has also been made for free medical check-up of all insured from local empanelled doctors and also thorough medical examination on 8 February every year. Certificate of insurance duly signed by United India & its intermediary M/s Instant Healthcare Pvt. Ltd., New Delhi have been provided to all the insured to facilitate medical check-up from empanelled doctors whenever required. Such welfare gesture has generated a great deal goodwill over & above belongingness among stakeholders.
