

## **Limca Book of Records give Indian Poet his Sixth National Record**

*Nikhil Parekh from Ahmedabad, India enters India's best book of Records as First Indian Poet to be Goodwill Ambassador to the Goodwill Treaty for World Peace*

**"Writing the most number of letters to and receiving the most number of replies from World Leaders and World Organizations".**

The Poet is an author of Poetry Books which include- "1 God" , "The Womb", "Love Versus Terrorism", "You die; I die- Love Poems", "Life=Death", "The Power of Black", "If you cut a tree; You cut your own mother", "Hide and Seek", "Longest Poem-Only as Life"—These comprise of over 7000 pages of his Poetry in totality.
